CLASSES:

- Baby class (4 6 months)
- **Puppy class** (6 9 months)
- Junior class (9 18 months)
- Intermediate class (15 24 months) is open to all dogs regardless of the tests passed or obtained awards
- Open class (since 15 months) is open to all dogs regardless of the tests passed or obtained awards.
- Working class (since 15 months) is open to all dogs with Working Certificate. This certificate is issued
 by organizations authorized by the ČMKU, or directly by the ČMKU.
- Winner class (since 15 months) is open to all dogs with titles: National winner, Club winner, Specialty winner, European winner or World winner or all dogs with adult Championship certificate.
- Veteran class (since 8 years)
- Honour class (since 15 months) is open to all dogs with titles: National winner, Club winner, Specialty
 winner, European winner or World winner or all dogs with adult Championship certificate, without
 entitlement awards. Excellent 1 from Honour class go to competition about Best of breed and Best of
 opposite sex.
- Out of competition class (since 15 months) in this class it is possible to show dogs without classification. The judge will draw up a show report and determine the ranking.

For all classes the age of the male/female on the day of the show is decisive. A male/female can only be entered in one of the above mentioned classes.

CLASIFICATION:

- Baby and Puppy class:
 very promising, promising, little promising the ranking of the first four individuals is determined)
- Junior, Intermediate, Open, Working, Winner, Veteran and Honour class:
 excellent, very good, good, satisfactory, disqualification, cannot be judged and did not arrive
 the ranking of the first four individuals is determined)

AWARDS:

- CAJC Certificate for the Czech Junior Champion title may be awarded to males and females graded as Excellent 1st in junior class.
- CAC Certificate for the Czech Champion title may be awarded to males and females graded Excellent 1st in Intermediate, Open, Working or and Winner class

TITLES:

- **Specialty winner** the best male and female of the breed from the competition of Excellent 1-CAC from the Intermediate class, Open class, Working class and Winner class.
- Specialty junior winner the best male and female from the competition of Excellent 1-CAJC from the Junior class
- Specialty veteran winner Excellent 1 male and female from the Veteran class
- Best of Juniors (BOJ) the title is awarded to the best junior in competition between male and female with CAJC (Junior class).
- Best of Veterans (BOV) the title is awarded to the best veteran in competition between male and female Excellent 1 in Veteran class.
- Best of breed (BOB) compete: the best junior male (CAJC) and female (CAJC), the best veteran male (Excellent 1 from the Veteran class) and female (Excellent 1 from the Veteran class), the best male and female from Honour class (Excellent 1 from Honour class) and both Specialty winners).
- Best of opposite sex (BOS) compete: the best junior male (CAJC) or female (CAJC), the best veteran male (Excellent 1 from the Veteran class) or female (Excellent 1 from the Veteran class), the best male or female from Honour class (Excellent 1 from Honour class), best adult individuals (Specialty winner) male or female, which are opposite sex than winner Best of breed.

The awarding of titles is non-claimable.

COMPETITIONS:

- Best Baby the best male or female (with Very promising 1) from the Baby class.
- Best Puppy the best male or female (with Very promising 1) from the Puppy class.

Competition has to be entered in advance in dogoffice system. Entry at the date of the show is not acceptable:

- Best Brace a male or female of one breed, that were judged at the show and are owned by one
 owner
- **Best breeding group** a breeder may register in the competition a minimum of three and a maximum of five individuals of one breed from his own breeding that come from different intercourses (at least from two different fathers or mothers) and were judged at the show. These individuals need not be owned by the breeder.
- Junior Handling this competition is a useful preparation for future exhibitors. The presentation of the dog is judged; this is why the quality of the presented dog is not decisive. Division of age categories:
 - 1st group 9-13 years
 - 2nd group 13-17 years

In the 9-13 years age category, those who reached the age of 13 at least one day before the show and do not reach the age of 13 on the day of the show may take part in the competition. In the 13-17 age category, those who reached the age of 13 at least one day before the show and do not reach the age of 17 on the day of the show may take part in the competition.

DOCUMENTS FOR PARTICIPATION:

- FCI pedigree
- EU Pet Passport with full vaccination
- Entry sheet

VETERINARY CONDITIONS:

All animals involved must be clinically healthy. Dogs must be fitted with a small animal passport or a vaccination certificate containing a record that the dog is immune to rabies in accordance with Section 4(1)(f) of the Veterinary Act. Dogs coming from EU Member States and third countries must be accompanied by a valid small animal passport and comply with the conditions laid down in Regulation 998/2003 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 26 May 2003. These regulations apply both to dogs exhibited and to dogs of visitors or participants in competitions and accompanying events.

GENERAL PROVISIONS

The show is organized in accordance with the provisions of the current version of the CMKU Show Regulation. The show is open to all males and females of the bearded collie breed registered in the studbook of the FCI member state or in the studbook of the country whose Pedigree is recognized by the FCI. All participants are obliged to comply with the Rules of Animal Protection in Public Performance and the Rules of Animal Protection and Dog Breeding.

The following individuals are excluded from participation at shows

- Dogs that are not written in the catalogue. An exception applies to the dogs that demonstrably are not
 written in the catalogue due to the fault of the organizer, and dogs whose assessment constitutes a
 document for their record into the Auxiliary Register.
- Dogs that are sick, suspected of having a disease, after an injury, females in the second half of pregnancy or nursing females.
- Dogs owned by persons whose right to exhibit was withdrawn.
- Dangerous dogs biting and aggressive toward people and dogs.
- Dogs with cropped ears.

It is forbidden to alter the coat, skin or muzzle of a dog with anything that changes its texture, colour or shape. It is forbidden to groom a dog on the show grounds with any substances or devices. Only clipping, trimming, combing and brushing are permitted. It is also forbidden to tie the dog on the trimming table for longer than necessary for grooming. Loud cheering of dogs from behind the ring (double-handling) is prohibited. It is also forbidden to attract the attention of dogs from outside the ring in any other way (e.g. using whistles, toys, food, calling to the dog, etc.). Violation of this prohibition may result in the dog being excluded from judging.

Exhibitors are responsible for the welfare of the dogs. It is forbidden to expose a dog to a situation that could endanger its health or welfare, such as leaving it in a vehicle in extreme heat or cold, or treating it in an abusive manner. Violation of this regulation will result in exclusion from that and subsequent shows. The promoter and show committee are not responsible for any illnesses of the dogs, death or loss of the dog and are not responsible for any damage caused by the dog during the show. The exhibitor is liable for damages caused by the dog. Owners must secure their animals for the duration of the show to prevent mutual attacks or possible injury to persons. The exhibitor acknowledges that he/she is obliged to maintain order in the show area. Bringing puppies for the purpose of selling them at the show is prohibited.

Exhibitors are obliged to comply with the provisions of the FCI and CMKU Show Regulations, these Regulations and the instructions of the Show Committee, which they undertake to do by submitting their application. In case the show is not held for objective reasons, the fees will be used to cover the costs of the show. An exhibitor who does not attend the show for any reason is not entitled to a refund of the show fee. The organiser has the right not to accept any exhibitor's entry, and has the right to reject and return entries and deposits received after the entry close. The organiser accepts no responsibility for undelivered entries. Changes of judges are subject to change.

ENTRY INSTRUCTIONS:

- entries are sent only through the on-line system DOGOFFICE.
- free charge competitions Child and dog and Junior handling are to entry in DOGOFFICE via Activities.
 Please send the name and age of your child to: kchbc@beardedcollie.cz
- each dog must have its own entry form
- discount for the second and additional dog can only be applied if the owner's name is the same as the first entry. The first dog is not eligible for the puppy, puppy, honorary and veteran classes.
- the entry form must be accompanied by a complete and legible photocopy of both sides of the pedigree card of the entered dog
- the information on the entry form must be identical to the information on the pedigree card of the dog entered. In case the application form does not contain the same data as the pedigree card attached to the application form, the application will not be accepted
- in the event that the titles obtained entitling the dog to the winner's class or the honorary class are not properly documented, the organizer is obliged to enter the dog in the open class
- the organizer of the show is not responsible for incorrectly filled in entry form (incorrect classification into classes, name of kennel, etc.)
- cancellation of the entry is possible only until the entry close- see the price list for cancellation from the show
- fees must be paid before entry close of the show for which the dog is entered and proof of payment must be submitted with the entry form

By submitting the application, the exhibitor agrees to the publication of his name and address in the catalogue. Photographs and videos may be taken at the show. By submitting an entry, the exhibitor agrees that he/she may be photographed and recorded. In points not mentioned in the regulations, the CMKU Show Regulations apply.

Entry sheets will be available for download in the system www.dogoffice.cz at least 5 days before the show.

PROTEST:
